Background and Charge:

The School of Business proposed a new track within the MBA program. The MBA program is already approved and the proposal adds a Strategy, Innovation, and Leadership (SIL) track to two already approved tracks. This proposal has been endorsed by the Dean of the School of Business. After a positive recommendation from the Graduate Studies Council, Steering charged CAP with considering whether all units that might be affected by the proposal have been consulted and whether the proposal is consistent with the College's mission.

<u>**Review</u>**: CAP reviewed the proposal and approvals from the curriculum committee and the Dean, both of the School of Business. All proposed track courses are within the School.</u>

Final Recommendation:

CAP determined that all affected units have been consulted and that the new track is consistent with the College's mission. CAP did not feel that further testimony was necessary and recommends approving the proposed additional track for the MBA program.
