4. Review of Liberal Learning Course: BUS 380: Law, Technology, and Business (seeking global civic responsibility)

GEC vote: GEC voted to recommend that BUS 380 be approved for global civic responsibility – members felt that the global civic responsibility is integral to the course concept and reflected in the syllabus, particularly in the required readings and assignments. The GEC, however, did wonder if the course title and course description should in some way register the international/global dimension of the course.

a. Supporting Communities of Learning (South Africa) - Jonathan Davis and Maureen Connolly


GEC vote: Unanimously approved
