#### 2) Review Charge of the Council

Review of purview for global engagement regarding study centers, partner institutions, faculty-led programs, providers.

Committee recently reviewed and codified processes, procedures, requests for proposals.

Council also advises on global engagement scholarships: ensured equity in distribution of funds because student need may be difficult to decode because of the complexity of aid passages.

Council periodically reviews new courses to determine whether they meet "global" requirements for liberal learning courses.

Council questions whether the last sentence refers to global engagement as curricular or philosophical or related to student life.

#### 3) Update from the Executive Director of Global Engagement

Olson summarized the nature of work over the last two years conducted by five groups communicated in the Global Engagement Review Report (August 21, 2019). Report is effectively a self-study.

Goal of the report was to create data-informed recommendations.

CGE built a strategic plan based on report. Strategic plan includes references to materials within the appendices of the report.
