RE: Final Recommendation on Graduate Certificate Program Proposal in Environmental Sustainability Education

DATE: March 6, 2020

Background and Charge:

Faculty members in the School of Education have developed a proposal for a Graduate Certificate in Environmental Sustainability Education (ESE). This proposal has been endorsed by the Dean of the School of Education and has been approved by the curriculum committee in the School of Education. Steering charged CAP with considering whether all units that might be affected by the proposal have been consulted and whether the proposal is consistent with the College's mission.

Review: CAP reviewed the proposal, endorsement from the Dean of the School of Education, and the approval of the School of Education's curriculum committee.

Final Recommendation:

CAP determined that all affected units have been consulted and that the new graduate certificate program is consistent with the College's mission. CAP did not feel that further testimony was necessary and unanimously approved the proposed Graduate Certificate in Environmental Sustainability Education (ESE).
