New Business

1. Review of New Faculty-Led Study Abroad Proposals

- a. CSC 1XX --Larry Pearlstein and Flori Pierri
 - i. Goal to design a course that would examine the history of science in Cambridge through the biographies of individuals who worked and studied in Cambridge. Currently looking for a departmental home (Computer Science has requested a revision of the original proposal). If it were to be a CSC course, it would be eligible for Quantitative Reasoning requirement.
 - ii. QR component of the course is based on the resemblance between this course and CSC 102 (course for non-majors).
 - iii. The course is approved conditional on its being **approved** by Computer Science by October 1, 2020.
- b. CRI 351--Comparative Criminology (Magaret Leigey)
 - i. Course would be offered in a Blended Learning model that would be online for the first few weeks and would include two site visits in the United States (NJ State Prison and Eastern State Penitentiary).
 - ii. Both US and Canada use an adversarial justice system but have a dramatically smaller incarcerated population. Canada chose a Rehabilitative model of corrections.
 - iii. Nine day visit to Canada.
 - iv. The course is **approved** with three suggestions: eliminate the prerequisite for the course and seek a social justice designation for the course.
