In the 2019-2020 academic year, CAP addressed the following:

- 1) Approved and/or reviewed eight program requests:
 - a. Graduate Certificate in Environmental Sustainability
 - b. Anthropology Major
 - c. Broadcast Journalism Minor
 - d. Music Technology Minor
 - e. Social Justice Minor
 - f. Nursing Education Track
 - g. EC EE Dual Certificate
 - h. Education - Biology dual major – revised requirements
- 2) Revised six policies
 - a. Course of Study Designation (Tier II) - revised and updated
 - b. Double Counting between Undergraduate and Graduate Courses (Tier II) – clarified policy
 - c. Readmission Conditional – Tier III updated to include clearer definitions and to merge separate policies into one
 - d. Special Topics Courses - Tier II revised and updated
 - e. Program and Curricular Change – Tier I revised to updated and revised to Curricular Change policy
 - f. Undergraduate Internship Policy – Tier I clarified submission application from students and added in definitional notes from General Counsel
- 3) Reviewed twos Committee requests
 - a. LLC asked us to review their course designation process in fall and an addendum in spring
- 4) Provided one emergency policy review to Steering on:
 - a. Ungraded Option for Spring 2020 in response to Covid-19 and remote learning
- 5) Five in-progress charges
