  - Alekhya
    - Re: altered funding for student groups; how will it be executed specifically, as in how will college-funded groups' DEI plans be reviewed as compared to SAF funded groups
    - Recommends that the line about Ambassadors and OLs simply be removed or relocated, as they are not equivalent to student orgs
  - Waheeda

- Advises that buy-in from stakeholders is necessary, especially as the principles of the manifesto become more concrete recommendations
- Overall happy with it, prefers it to the broad statement of principles
- Recommends “marginalized” over “minoritized”
- Will there be a more substantial document that reflects more stakeholder groups later on? Perhaps we should allude to that?
  - Yes, the forthcoming inclusive excellence plan will include many more stakeholder groups
- Chief Grant
  - Does BLM Movement refer to something more or above just Black Lives Matter? If so do we need the term “Movement” in there at all?
- Marvin
  - Wonders if some sort of review board or ombudsman office could be established to directly address students’ concern of lack of accountability
- Aniefre
  - Training for faculty advisors so they can more inclusively recruit for their student orgs and foster more inclusive cultures therein
