### **MINUTES**

- Update on student issues from SG representatives
  - Uyen: student gov has been compiling resources for students affected by COVID, collaborating with other student governments to create master website
    - No discrete number for affected individuals, but has noticed many are remaining anonymous
  - o New eboard members are transitioning in, new VP for DEI will be introduced

- Dean Hall wonders how/if he and others can donate to students in need; Uyen to discuss with SG cabinet and get back to us with details
- Update on CDC recommendation to Steering
  - James Felton meeting with Steering today to discuss revised place for CDC
  - o Jamal wants to be sure his concerns are adequately expressed up the chain
    - Centralization of control/authority for DEI issues in the VP for DEI/CDC
    - Over-emphasis on incident response rather than infrastructure building
- Possible new meeting day next academic year
  - Currently, Steering and CDC meet on same day/time; if James joins committee,
    CDC meeting time will have to change
  - Stay tuned for change in meeting schedule come September 2020
- <u>Discussion/feedback Draft mission of the Division of Equity and Inclusion</u>
  - o Jamal, Uyen, and Waheeda prefer draft 2
    - Waheeda views it as the most inclusive of ongoing efforts while still being broad enough for later revision/addition
    - Tieka notes that it doesn't mention community or physical accessibility
  - o Maurice wants "our purpose" line from draft 3 included
    - Appreciates the explicit, actionable language being used, worries about "strategic ambiguity" in DEI mission statements
    - Jamal agrees, but does worry about the measurability aspect; draft 2 allows for more wiggle room
  - Uyen is going to solicit feedback from other SG reps
  - Kerri will bring feedback to drafting group and forward new draft ASAP
- Student Conduct/Title IX update
  - Jamal will forward CDC the proposed changes to Conduct/Title IX code for review
- Intergroup Dialogue
  - Obviously unable to pilot program this year due to restrictions
