1) February 24th meeting minutes

A. Approved

2) Visit from Frank Cooper, Executive Director of the Office of Records and Registration on proposal to suspend classes on November election day

- A. Issues to consider
 - 1. Instructional hours minimum (Course unit is 60 contact hours) during the semester. So, eliminating a Tuesday is a problem because fall is already short a class day.
 - 2. State holidays and energy days interact for staff
 - 3. Fall semester starts with convocation
 - 4. Contract with Sodexho incorporates "feeding days"
 - 5. Tuesday off might cause students to skip the Monday before
 - 6. Alternative forms of voting might reduce need to leave campus to vote
 - (1) Voting is not the only form of engagement on election day
 - (2) A ballot drop-off box has been installed
- B. Discussion of whether to take election day off and alternatives for implementation
 - 1. Passed motion to support voting on Election Day and broad, deep civic engagement by students, staff, and faculty; recommend that the academic readiness guidelines task force incorporate a call to encourage voting; and table the formal request to suspend classes on election day in November 2021 and consider it again at the beginning of fall semester 2021.
