Approval of the November 4 minutes (Rachel will put them together for next meeting)

Judi Cook, Director of OID: Flex Model Pilot Student Survey Preliminary data: ~ 400 students were surveyed/250 responded (of the 250 - 78% remote) (20 faculty members participated in pilot)

Anecdotal reported: Students favored in person model - (found it engaging, students were able to focus, no at home distractions). Fully remote students 60% reported the audio was an issue. Partner with MTSS to help faculty with audio for spring term. Students also reported equity and safety protocols were an issue.

Students reported they felt the pilot was an experiment.

Student represented in fall flex pilot were from SOE and HSS

OID team is planning to hold a training on inclusive teaching strategies in January (some topics may include (UDL, equity and inclusiveness, canvas, accessibility, measuring community course communication...). Recommendation: Faculty need to be involved.

Brenda Leake: Tim Clysdale working on orientation for Adjunct Faculty. Construct a virtual orientation that can be accessed asynchronously.
