1) General Discussion

a) The minutes from 2/3/21 were approved.

2) Update from Judi Cook:

- a) Judi will present to the Council of Deans a proposal to reimagine the College's blended and online course development. Judi will advocate for strategic employment of digital pedagogy.
- b) Because the PAWs system is not centralized, in-person courses were improperly coded as blended or online courses. Judi sent emails to faculty and staff to correct these errors.
- c) The Office of Instructional Design continues to offer timely and relevant workshops to faculty and staff such as *Teaching Accessibility in Computer Science* with Dr. Andrea Salgian and *Idea Showcase: The Online Exhibit Assignment* with Dr. Cynthia Paces. These workshops are offered live at a scheduled time and also recorded for faculty and staff to view at a later date.

3) Update from Brenda Leake:

- - i) The Teaching and Learning Center will offer a total of 5 "book chats" at various times via Zoom meetings on 3/15/21, 3/16/21 and 3/19/21.
 - ii) Each book chat should include a maximum of 25 participants. Note, 155 faculty and staff requested this year's Good Reads book selection.

 - i) On 3/17/21, the Docustory Learning Community will premiere the Docustory at a screening with President Foster, the President's Cabinet and the students who participated in the project. After this initial screening, the Docustory will be released to the campus community.
