 1. Overview of sheet and what we are doing today
 - a. We have not yet received formal requests to schedule, but many have tentatively indicated this to Christa
 - b. Spread of countries: need to discuss. Do we have a balanced portfolio?
 - c. Liberal learning and disciplinary attributes: need to discuss
 - d. Today: need to make a decision about the winter and spring schedule. Then, think about the new proposals for Summer 2023 (are proposals in good shape? Does this suite of programs work?)
 - b. [Faculty Led Program Details Winter 2023](#)
 - i. Dominican Republic: Proposal is not going forward at this time. There are now only 3 programs slated for winter
 - ii. In the future for proposals: Should we consider adding guidelines about having a departmental conversation?
 - iii. Challenges of two Greece Program
 1. Should programs rotate, for example should the two Greece programs run in alternate years?

 - 1. Typical questions:
 - a. Give instructors an opportunity to bring alive the itinerary
 - b. Questions are typically about how they will make elements of the syllabus mesh with the itinerary.
 - c. What are questions that remain from the application?
 - d. How do we handle the situation if one or both faculty is new to the country?
 - 2. New questions:
 - a. What is the plan for recruitment?
 - b. What do you think is the demand for the new course?
 - c. Can they recruit outside their discipline?
 - d. How does this course work with the rest of the curriculum in your home department?
 - e. Does the course's learning goals align well with (or attempted to make appropriate links toward) the Global Engagement Outcomes available in page 14 of RFP and the rubric?
 - f. For Greece course in Summer 2023: How does this differ from the other Greece program? Is this a duplicated course or is this a distinct course? Did you coordinate this course with the leaders of the other Greece course?
 - iii. After we read requests for proposals for other programs, we reserve the right to invite additional people to talk about their programs.
