Collaborating Across Boundaries

- National Science Foundation funded program
 - Have a no cost extension for one more year
- Should be designated for CAB classes to institutionalize CAB and streamline process for automation
- Best practices are having them meet at the same time with classes next to each other and have a joint Canvas shell
 - Prioritize larger class sizes for capacity
 - Having a joint Canvas shell is now a legal requirement
- Considering additional compensation for faculty
 - 0.5 hours as additional compensation as faculty weighted hours
- Institutionalizing instructional internships to run programs
- Benefits of model and approach to CEL
 - Practical skills collaborating with communities and communicating with external stakeholders

- Articulate best practices and benefits of ACEL courses to faculty and give weight in evaluation
- There is a need for ongoing research into the issues of how to structure collaborations in ways that result in further improvements
- CEL Council could gather testimony and put through governance
- CAB is well suited for ACEL
- Faculty have a full semester of preparation
- Participating faculty have been paid
- Model could be institutionalized with CEL Institute
- Incorporate faculty mentoring
