 - d. The 1st Annual Teaching and Learning Summit was a great success. The opening keynote was attended by 166 colleagues (96 in the room and 70 via Zoom). We offered 19 different workshops with 31 presenters. We had 129 attending in the morning and 121 in the afternoon sessions. As of the date of the meeting 69 participants have completed the survey on their experience.
