Committee on Faculty Affairs Year End Report 2021-2022

During the 2021-2022 academic year CFA completed work and submitted final recommendations to Steering for the SOSA, Assessment of Advising, and Service Section of the RPD charges. CFA updated and approved the Financial Conflict of Interest policy and Retention of Student Work policy, and reviewed and approved the Sabbatical RFP. In addition, CFA collected MOA #128/139 Compliance documents from Chemistry (3 faculty), Computer Science (2 faculty), Library (1 faculty), Art and Art History (2 faculty), and Music (1 faculty). CFA approved the Disciplinary Standards for Biomedical Engineering and Special Education, Language and Literacy. Pending minor revisions, CFA gave provisional approval to the Communication Studies Department's Disciplinary Standards. CFA reviewed and provided feedback on the Disciplinary Standards for Criminology, Creative Writing, Counselor Education, English, and Math/Statistics; CFA will return to those Disciplinary Standards in fall 2022, once revised versions of the Disciplinary Standards have been received. CFA received the Disciplinary Standards for Anthropology/Sociology in May 2022 and will provide feedback in fall 2022. CFA completed the preliminary recommendations and a first round of public testimony for the Student Feedback Form charge and the Undergraduate Advising Policies and Practices charge; CFA will prepare final recommendations in fall 2022. CFA drafted a preliminary recommendation for the Copyrighted Materials Use charge and will seek public testimony in fall 2022.
