- New from Brenda Seals (rec'd late May 2022)
 - Graduate Certificate in Health and Risk Communication
 - o Committee discussed feedback on the proposal, including:
 - Why 9 vs.12 credits? Include rationale in proposal.
 - Is there a demand or market for having a certificate in this area? What evidence or citations support the demand in this area?
 - Current enrollment in these courses? How does this certificate affect/shape/compliment the current graduate certificate?
 - The committee agrees the certificate is important for public health, especially in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic.
 - It would be helpful to clearly document what skillset is offered through the program or how this certificate shapes a student's career (strengthened rationale).
- Dr. Jason Dahling 2pm follow up re: Organizational Leadership Certificate
 - Jason provided an overview of the rationale for this proposal.
 - We moved through questions from the committee, including and especially reasons for and feasibility of hybrid modality.

- The committee also discussed collaborations with School of Business. School of Business would like to further discuss collaborations and partnerships with the proposal.

- The committee discussed the original feedback and concerns, including:
 - Modality (virtual vs. in person) and delivery
 - The proposal states that simulcast undergrad courses will be recorded for viewing at a later date. GSC feels this might not be best practice and encourages collaboration with the Office of Instructional Design.
