- 1. Announcements
  - a. Discussion on furniture for classrooms for next academic year (samples are displayed in the model classroom Forcina 411)
- 2. Approval for Environmental Sustainability Dual Major --- postponed until next meeting
- 3. Spanish 4+1 ESL
  - a. Joint effort between Dr. Wu and Spanish Department (once approved can be for any linguistic program not just for Spanish program)
  - b. 4 years including studying aboard junior year, senior year begin ESL courses. Finish 5 year program with certification in TTSL, fulfilling requirements with the DOE and will receive a Spanish teaching certificate for their major
  - c. Grant applied for to assist with program to begin in Fall 2024 to partner up with Ewing HS to recruit native Spanish speakers to come to TCNJ, thus increasing ESL teachers and teachers of Spanish
- 4. Accreditation
