Reviewed four Disciplinary Standards Last Fall; Received two new DSs

Review of Faculty Emeritus Policy: have a draft preliminary recommendation that they will submit to Council of Deans and Faculty Senate Executive Board; suggesting change to IIIA about rights and privileges; added Assistant Director of the Library to eligible ranks and add the lecturer and senior and master clinical specialists. Removed the stipulation about tenure from IIIB. Added a statement that people must be in good standing at the time of retirement with no disciplinary action pending and no criminal issues during employment. Need an extension to March 30 - granted.

Review of the Reappointment and Promotions Documentl. Need an extension to May 10 - granted.

Question: Charged to review the use of copyrighted material in 2021. 2023 Chair requested a pause. Steering will need to recharge the committee to restart the process.
