## **New Business**

- a. Haley B., student representative, graduated and will no longer be on GSC; looking for a new student representative
- b. Feedback on proposal for the Post Bacc Certification in Innovation and Creativity in Education
  - 1. Discussion Question: Would current (under)graduate students take the courses?
    - What is the policy on credit-threshold for graduate students seeking a graduate degree program
    - Discussion on new policy on maximum of three graduate courses
    - Who is this certification envisioned for? Who is each class intended for?
      - Market analysis needed to determine the target audience beyond what is provided in the proposal.
      - Will students not planning on taking the certificate be able to enroll in the classes offered in the program?
  - 2. Further discussion on course timing, audience, and relation to learning goals and outcomes
    - The program itself has goals, program details, but it does not have the "critical" aspect of the curriculum proposed in the learning outcomes?
      - Suggestion: Outlining how each course will meet each learning outcome
    - Is this for current students, current teachers, both?
      - Who asked (schools, teachers, TCNJ students?)
    - Is this for a specific education concentration (elementary, secondary, special ed., etc.)?
  - 3. Further questions on the program
    - What are the other certificate programs (beyond certification programs) offered through TCNJ SOE?
    - What would enrollment look like; what is the cost-benefit of adding this certificate program?

- 4. Need SOE Dean Tabitha Dell'Angelo to clarify these concerns about this certification program
  - Clarification on the dual-appointment for staff/faculty for proposal process
  - Inform Dean DellAngelo: Needs curriculum committee approval through home department and school
