[Summary of Submissions](#)
 - A. **Ria Rodney** - Global Perspective in Health Education in US Virgin Island
 - Focus on maternal health at a woman infant children clinic
 - Available to students w/o passport
 - R. Rodney used to be nurse in Virgin Islands
 - Students will learn about slave trade in the Caribbean and its colonial history
 - There is an over representation of deaf or hard of hearing; ASL students would be a good fit
 - 10 no more than 12 to keep clinical visits smaller and make transportation easier
 - Graduate students also allowed to participate
 - Students will be able to study in an environment where 90% of population's healthcare via Medicaid
 - Students will learn about tropical medicine and Caribbean culture

 - A) **Mindi McMann** - Portrait of 20th Century Ireland - Marginalized Voices Ireland & Northern Ireland
 - Up to 25 students
 - Global designation and seeking a race and Ethnicity for College Core
 - 100 level not intimidating for students
 - Willing to change topic title to attract more students, i.e. "Black Ireland - Marginalized Voices in Irish Literature "
