    - ii. We could look at other approvals from FY25 to see if there are other retroactive approvals worth considering
    - iii. Retroactive approval could have problematic impacts on ongoing course registrations, may not accurately reflect revisions made to courses as part of the CCC review process
    - iv. Consensus was that retroactive approval should not beimplemented, but students who have extenuating

circumstances that might warrant an exception should be directed to the Associate Provost who will review these requests on a case-by-case basis.
