i. Literary, Visual, and Performing Arts

● Discussion

- LVPA goal was modified on the syllabus, would need to be included verbatim
- Proposer did not complete rationale prompts tying course materials / assessments to learning outcome
- Balance between video technique and art critique
- Feedback for proposer
  - Get learning outcome explicitly on syllabus
  - Complete all rationale prompts
  - In particular, tell us more about balance of technique / critique and to what extent meaningful critique / cultural evaluation is occurring

3. Updates from Faculty Senate College Core Discussions

- a. Faculty Senate is still weighing appropriateness / readiness of currently proposed models for future of College Core
- b. Steering will send us goals (potentially with models) for feedback
- c. Next steps in the process?
  - i. Mix of disciplinary experts and external disciplines reviewing outcomes?
  - ii. Determine the importance of proposed outcomes / skills to ALL students
    - 1. What curriculum most effectively delivers those outcomes / skills
    - 2. To what extent should curriculum be prescribed / open; isolated / integrated
  - iii. Take inventory of degree level goals, universal overlaps
  - iv. Testimony collection
    - 1. Is it possible to streamline testimony collection, present a proposal that incorporates outcomes AND model before seeking community testimony
  - v. High level - Kit proposed approving goals (without wordsmithing), sending goals out to campus community for feedback, and approving models sent from Steering while community feedback on goals is being collected
  - vi. Importance of advancing goals / model that will enhance faculty buy-in
