### **New Business**

- Approved minutes from 2/19/25
- GSC discussion of the Career and Technical Education (CTE) graduate certificate, and how this certificate would provide a path to graduate credit to those in the alternate path licensure path program and who have completed bachelor's degrees.
  - Existing CTE noncredit courses serve individuals on the state-approved alternate path licensure program for teaching in one of the approved CTE fields, and these courses map onto existing MAT and M.Ed graduate courses.
  - This grad certificate cannot be granted until the student obtains their licensure.
  - This grad certificate will offer a path to the MAES.
  - The CTE courses will be housed in the School of GGOE.
- Discussion of CAP restructuring proposal draft to merge GSC with CAP. Problems discussed with this proposal include: this will be more difficult organizationally and logistically than two separate committee, number of people required to sufficiently represent all parties (18+) will lead to further inefficiency, proposal does not include giving graduate studies committee oversight of graduate student policy which is essential, and standard organizational structure at other colleges and universities has a separate graduate studies council.
