- a. We would like to work with faculty to determine ways to globalize their courses, whether or not there is a travel component. Perhaps a workshop or small seminar setting to get faculty thinking about this. We could use the GEC's support in building this and helping to encourage faculty participation.
- b. We would like to lean on the GEC to develop programming related to our international students on campus.
- c. Utilizing our study centers as extensions of the TCNJ classroom- using resources that exist elsewhere in TCNJ-based classes.
- d. Continued focus on selecting programs that are accessible (financially and geographically) that will attract students.
- e. Main focus: Running more of the planned programming. Will need to focus on supporting faculty with marketing and ensuring that same-term locations/topics do not negatively affect one another.
