 - a. Sherlene is working with R&R to remove basic skills from students accounts
 - b. NJ Legislation states, in order to get a limited CEAS, students do have to pass the basic skills exam
 - c. Suggestions for programs is to put a hold on students below 2.75 so that they must come into advising to be told before they come into CPI
 - d. Students going into CPI do not have to take the basic skills test however, if they have a GPA below 2.75 and they're going to be enrolling in CPI, they may have the option of the Limited CEAS --- vote taken YES: majority / NO: 0
