- 1. Support after difficult or traumatic violence-related school-based experiences --- Zach Gall of Anti Violence Initiatives
 - a. (2) swatting incidents in the past year and a half in field placements involving our student teachers
 - b. CARE referrals can be submitted by faculty who are concerned with students situations counseling, food pantry, emergency housing, etc.
 - c. AmIOk Program grant funded and operated in Forcina Hall also used by other colleges in Mercer County
 - d. No solid protocols in place when student deaths occur in field experiences involving student teachers teaching those students
 - e. Info on direct services for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing students

2. Basic Skills / Praxis

- a. New legislation related to basic skills
 - i. Still waiting for guidance from the DOE. New legislation only applies to students pursuing a CE (as of right now). Students still need to take the basic skills.
- b. Students in top 50 percentile of the SAT/ACT do not need to take basic skills. Students who do not submit passing scores by 1/18 will be dropped from CPI
